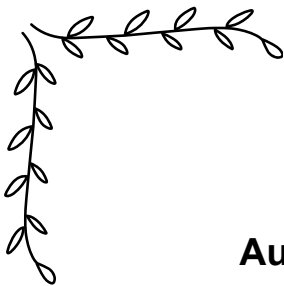

Scripture: “The earth is the Lord’s, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein.”

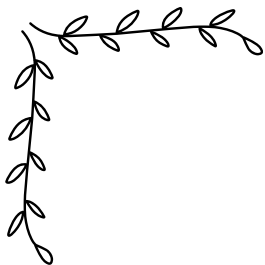
Psalm 24:1 (NKJV)

Faithful in the Ordinary

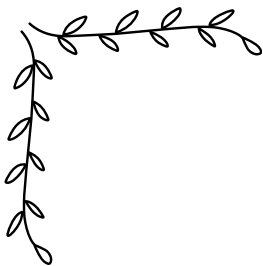
Scripture: “He who is faithful in what is least is faithful also in much.” Luke 16:10a (NKJV)

Living with Open Hands

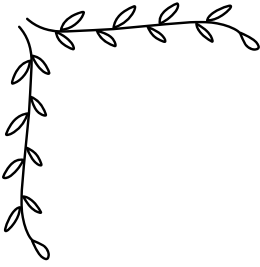
Scripture: “Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights.” James 1:17a (NKJV)
